Veterans of Foreign Wars and American Legion facilities, Wright-Patterson Air Force Base and other potential military and civilian locations.

Media: Oil, acrylic, and transparent watercolor paintings, photography, or three-Dimensional sculpture and art objects. Works on paper include pastel, pencil, charcoal and colored pencil. This exhibit is open to all military, professional and student artists from around the world. The theme for this year's exhibits is Reflections of Life.

Note: This year's theme was specifically selected to allow for drawings and paintings of mood through landscape, portraiture and still life to be incorporated into the Reflections of Generosity (RoG) exhibit.

Work Size: Works submitted must be two or three dimensional and original in concept, design and execution. Installation artwork requires special review and approval. There is no minimum or maximum size restriction. Entries must be framed, gallery wrapped, and include appropriate display material for a gallery setting.

Entry Requirements: Each artist may enter up to three works of art and exceptions for additional works will be made on a case-by-case basis. High quality digital images of each art piece must be submitted for judging. Images should be in jpg format. Submissions may include Zip archives, JPG images, PDF, Text(.txt), and Microsoft Word documents. Other file formats, including applications, slide shows, flash, etc. may delay the review of your work. The primary point of contact for all submissions is as follows:

Reception: Opening receptions will be announced through the RoG Facebook page and through press releases.

Picking up artwork: Artwork will be available after each exhibit. If you would like your artwork to continue to other military installations throughout the year, please let us know on your entry form.

Shipped artworks: All shipped art pieces will require return shipping to be paid by the artist unless the artist has granted RoG permission to continue exhibiting the work.
